Participation Contract and General Terms and Conditions

1. Project Overview

The SAOS Orchestra Academy is conceived for music students and professional musicians in the early stages of their career. Of course we also welcome ambitious and able participants whose career is not in music, but who wish to develop their instrumental and orchestral skills further.

All the lecturers of the SAOS Orchestra Academy are professors at music academies as well as soloists, concertmasters and solo players of internationally renowned orchestras. The SAOS Orchestra Academy aims to offer an intense exploration of the special performance practice required by the First Viennese School, accompanied and guided by instructors with excellent references in this specific repertoire. The concerts of the 2019 SAOS Orchestra Academy are planned as part of the "Salzburg Festival Opening Party", offer a perfect opportunity to fulfill our ambition in this respect. Our goal is to give each participant in the 2019 SAOS Orchestra Academy a lasting impression of "our" performance style in the classical concert and orchestral repertoire, which may accompany them on their musical paths through life. The SAOS Orchestra Academy takes place at the Musikum Salzburg. This "House of Music" not only offers professional working conditions, but is also located in the immediate vicinity of the performance venues of the world's largest and probably also most important festival for classical music, the Salzburg Festival.

1.1 Date and Venue

The Academy will take place from July 15, 2019 (arrival until July 14, 5 p.m.) to July 20, 2019 (departure July 21st until 11 a.m.) at the Musikum Salzburg, Schwarzstrasse 49, A-5020 Salzburg.

1.2 Admissions

Only persons of age (18 years old or above on February 28, 2019), or persons below the age of 18 but accompanied by legal guardian(s), have admission to the Academy. All costs for the accompanying person will be charged separately as needed.

1.2 Lessons

The participants obligate themselves to attend the daily lessons, be on time and check the daily rehearsal schedule. The schedule will be sent after application due to January 31, 2019.

1.4 Final Concerts

At the end of the Academy the participants will perform in two public concerts on July 20, 2019.

2. Pricing

ORCHESTRA-MODULE

Participation fee: € 490.-

Includes: 6 orchestra rehearsals, 1 sectional rehearsal, additional coaching by section during rehearsals by our lecturers, concert on July 20, 2019, farewellparty

MASTERCLASS-MODULE

Participation fee: € 690.-

Includes: 7 hours of individual lessons, final concert, farewellparty

MIXED-MODULE

Participation fee: € 690.-

Includes: 2 hours of individual lessons, orchestra module, concert on July 20, 2019, farewellparty

PERCUSSION-MODULE

Main emphasis at SAOS Orchestra Academy 2019

Participation fee: active € 690.- / passive € 290.-

Includes: 8 different master classes for viennese timpani system, berlin timpani system, orchestral percussion and solo repertoire, 6 ensemble rehearsals with lecturers, concert with lecturers on July 20, 2019, farewellparty

ALL-IN MODULE

Participation fee: € 1300.- (bookable until January 31, 2019)

Includes: Orchestra-Module, Masterclass-Module, 7 nights single room

The association Salzburg Orchestra Soloists is exempt from turnover tax according to § 6 Abs. 1 Z. 25 UStG.

A 50% deposit from the participation fee is to be transferred until latest February 28, 2019 to the account at Volksbank

Only after receiving the payment, the participation at the Academy is granted and the confirmation of admission will be sent to the participant.

The remaining amount is to be transferred until latest June 30, 2019 to the same account.

3. Cancellation

After the successful confirmation of admission to the Academy according to 2., a cancellation of the participation can only be facilitated in approved cases of force majeure (severe illness, accident, death in the family). In case of inability to participate through force majeure, an immediate cancellation in form of a written and attested notice about the cancellation's reason is needed. Otherwise the whole amount of the participation fee has to be paid. In cases of force majeure, the organiser of the Academy withholds the processing fee, which amounts to € 290,-. As soon as the Academy starts, cancellations are not possible anymore.

4. Insurance

For the duration of the Academy, a personal liability insurance and a limited health insurance for the participant is contracted by the Academy if the participant cannot submit his own insurance. The insurance contribution of € 25,- will be collected at the venue. The Academy assumes no liability for any accidents, thefts or damages of any kind during the stay in Salzburg.

5. Visa

The participant is in charge of requesting visa and valid travel documents necessary for entering and exiting Austria. Additionally, it is in the participant's sphere to prepare all documents in time and pay the costs involved.

6. Storage of personal data

The participant declares his/her agreement to the storage of personal data (first and surname, address and e-mail) within the scope of the DSGVO (Austrian Data Protection Authority). The participants' data can be used for informational purposes as newsletters or any digital information for upcoming events of the SAOS Orchestra Academy.

7. Audio recording, photographs and filming

7.1 Subject matter

Photographs, audio- and video recording of the participant taken within the SAOS Academy 2019.

7.2 Intended purpose

7.3 Declaration

The participant declares his/her agreement with usage free of charge of all recordings and photographs of his/her person for the reasons as described above. If the signatory does not accept he/she will not suffer any disadvantages. The agreement can be revoked anytime with future effect.

8. Legal Scope

For all matters of this contract solely Austrian Law is applicable. The parties agree on Salzburg as place of jurisdiction. Any verbally and additionally made agreements need to be approved in a written manner by the Head of the Academy. However, the effectiveness of this contract in its whole remains.
